GOALS OF THE AICEP

Support

Provide communities with support to establish an understanding of their energy needs and opportunities.

Inform

Engage the community on opportunities and requirements for undertaking electricity conservation.

Implement

Develop an implementation plan that will set out an approach to achieve the community's goals for electricity use and generation opportunities.

1 year to complete the community energy plan

Work Plan and Budget

Outline in detail all of the work and costs required to develop your Community Energy Plan.

Project Team

Describe the role and experience of all people who will be involved in developing the Plan.
