## Goals of the AISP

- Increase participation in Climate Leadership initiatives to reduce community Greenhouse gas emissions.
- Assist in the transition to a lower carbon economy.
- Create more sustainable community energy generation.



## What is the Grant for?

Grants to Indigenous communities who install solar photovoltaics (PV) on community owned facilities.

Funding for your new solar project is available to a **\$200,000** max or **60%** of total project cost. Remote and diesel based power generation communities are eligible for up to **\$5,000** in additional funding.

## Ready... Set... Apply!

Interested communities can submit a proposal when the GoA issues a call for proposals.

### Proposal must include:

- Initiative description
- Work plan and budget
- Project Team

### Submission

Your proposal must be submitted in hard copy or soft copy (CD-ROM or USB)

### Review & Evaluation

Proposals reviewed and evaluated

### Contract

Funding Offered to selected proponents

### Completion Assessment

Project to be evaluated for completion based on proposal submitted
